

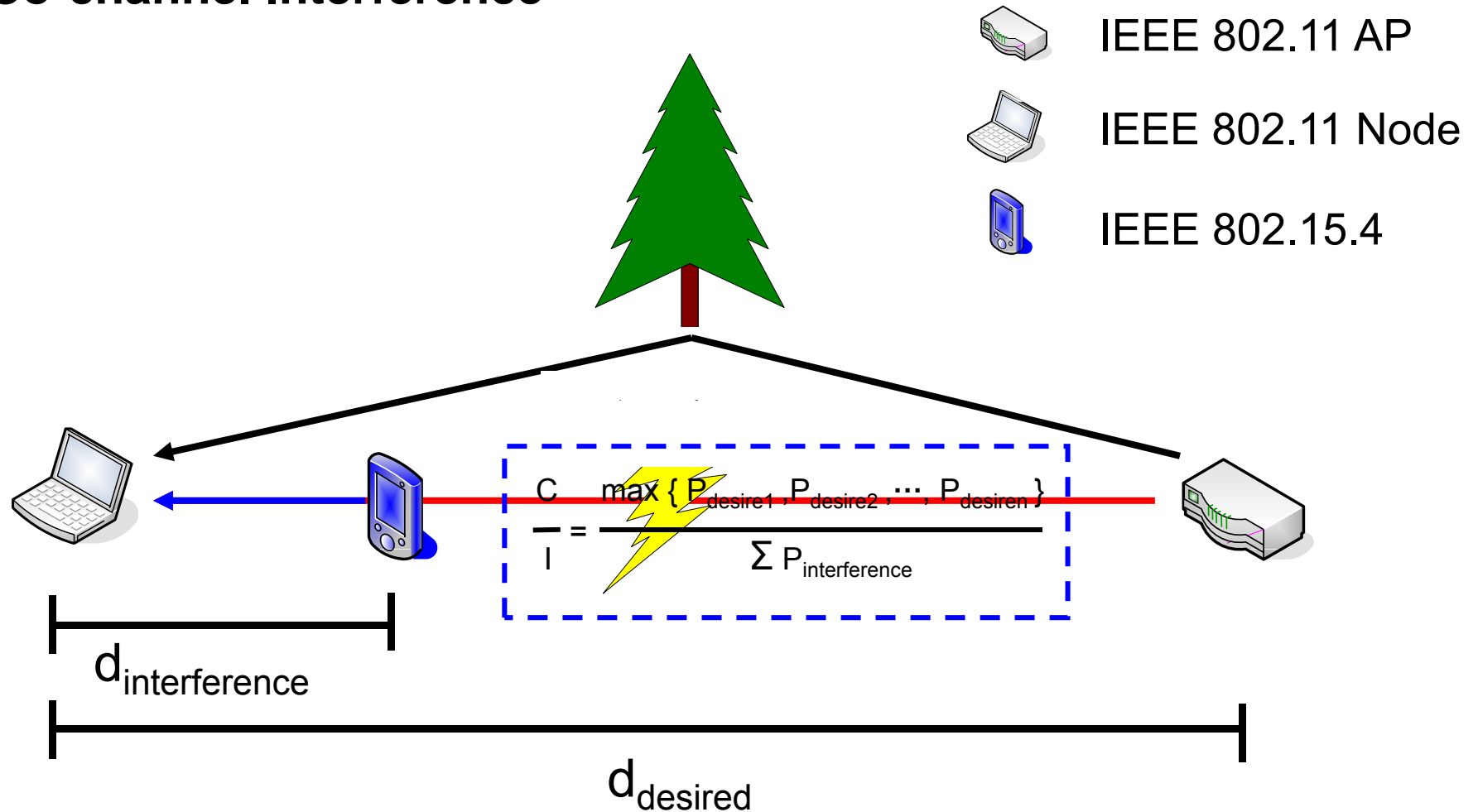

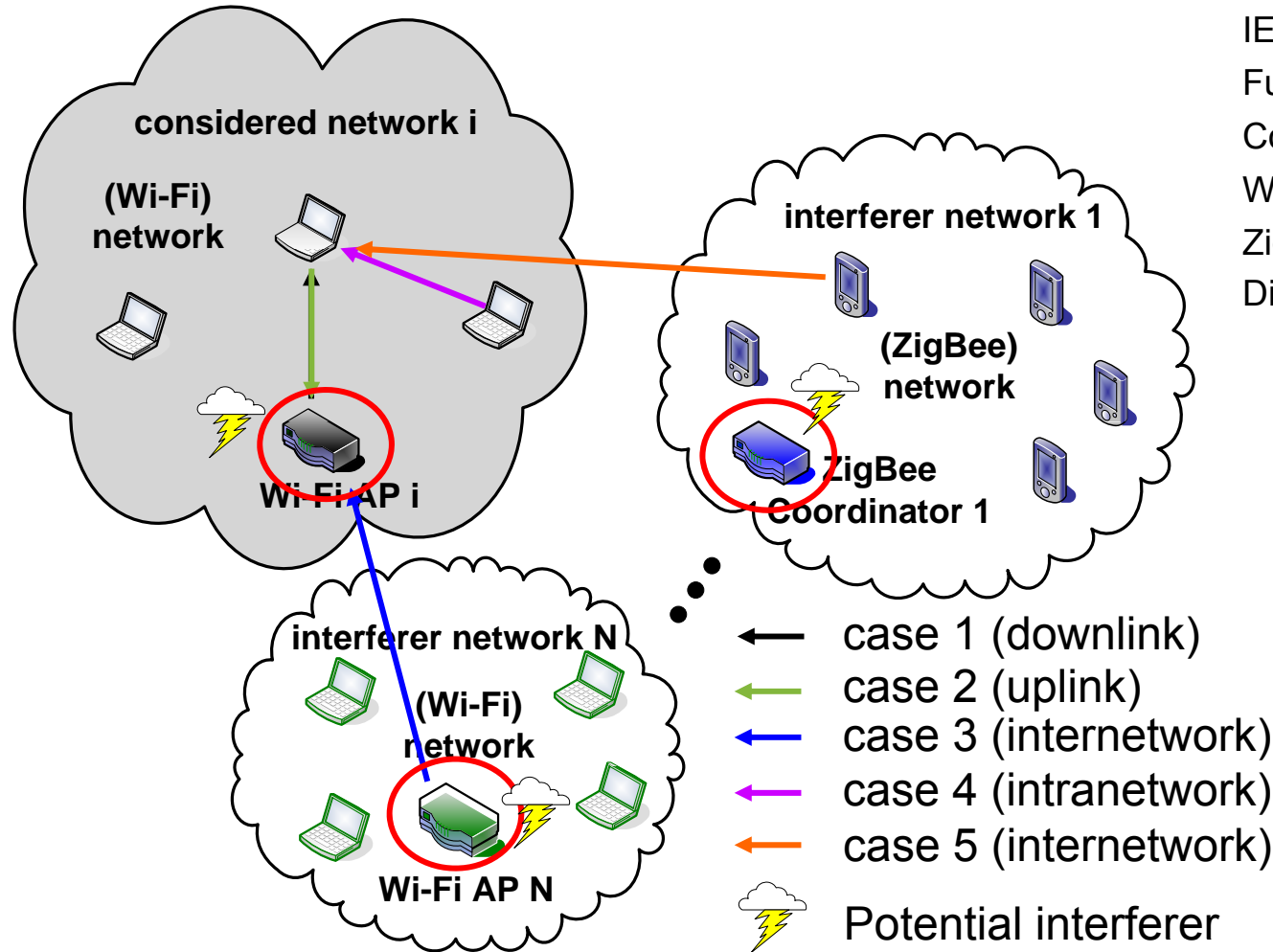


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Co-channel Interference

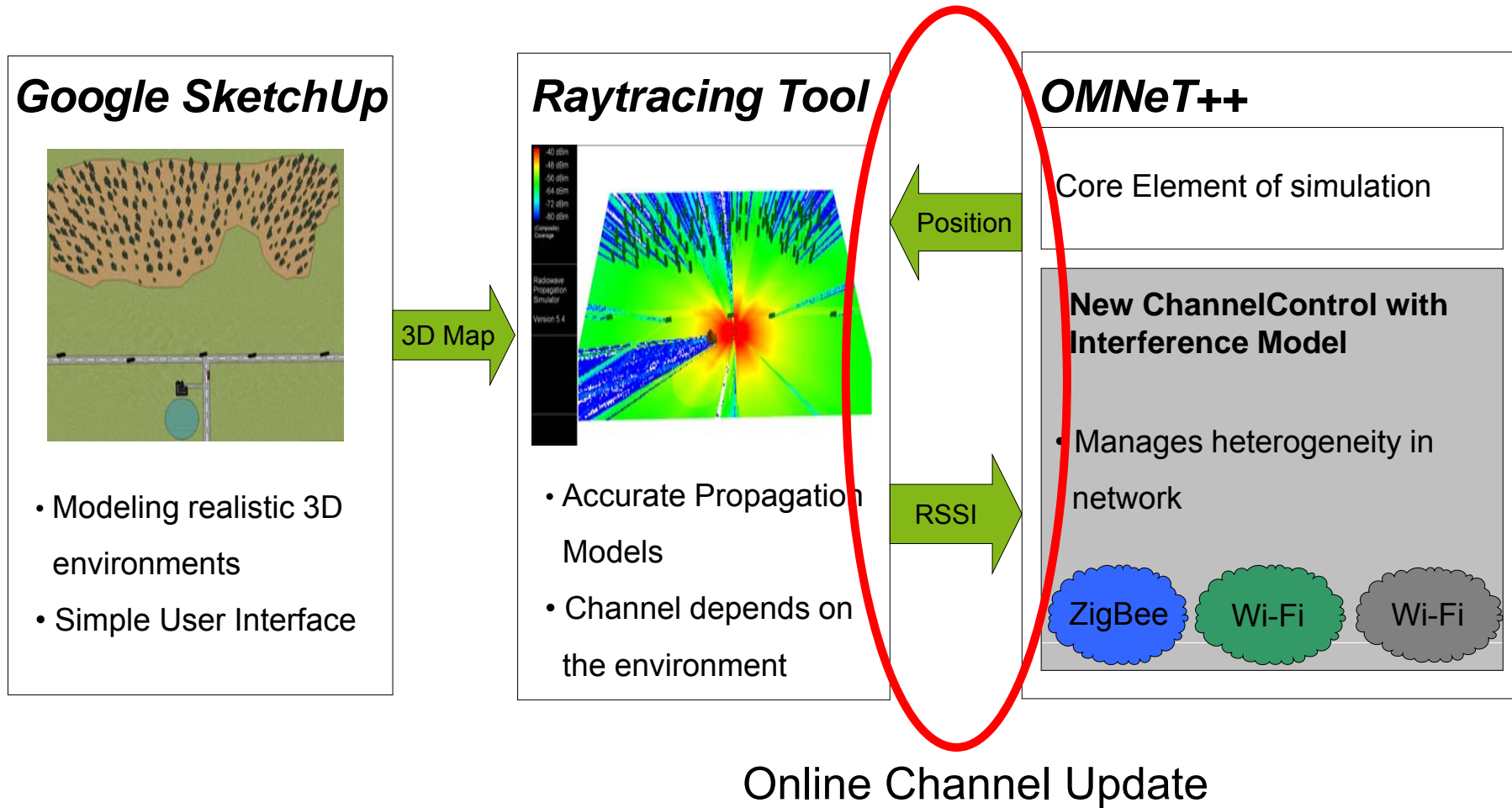


Interference Model

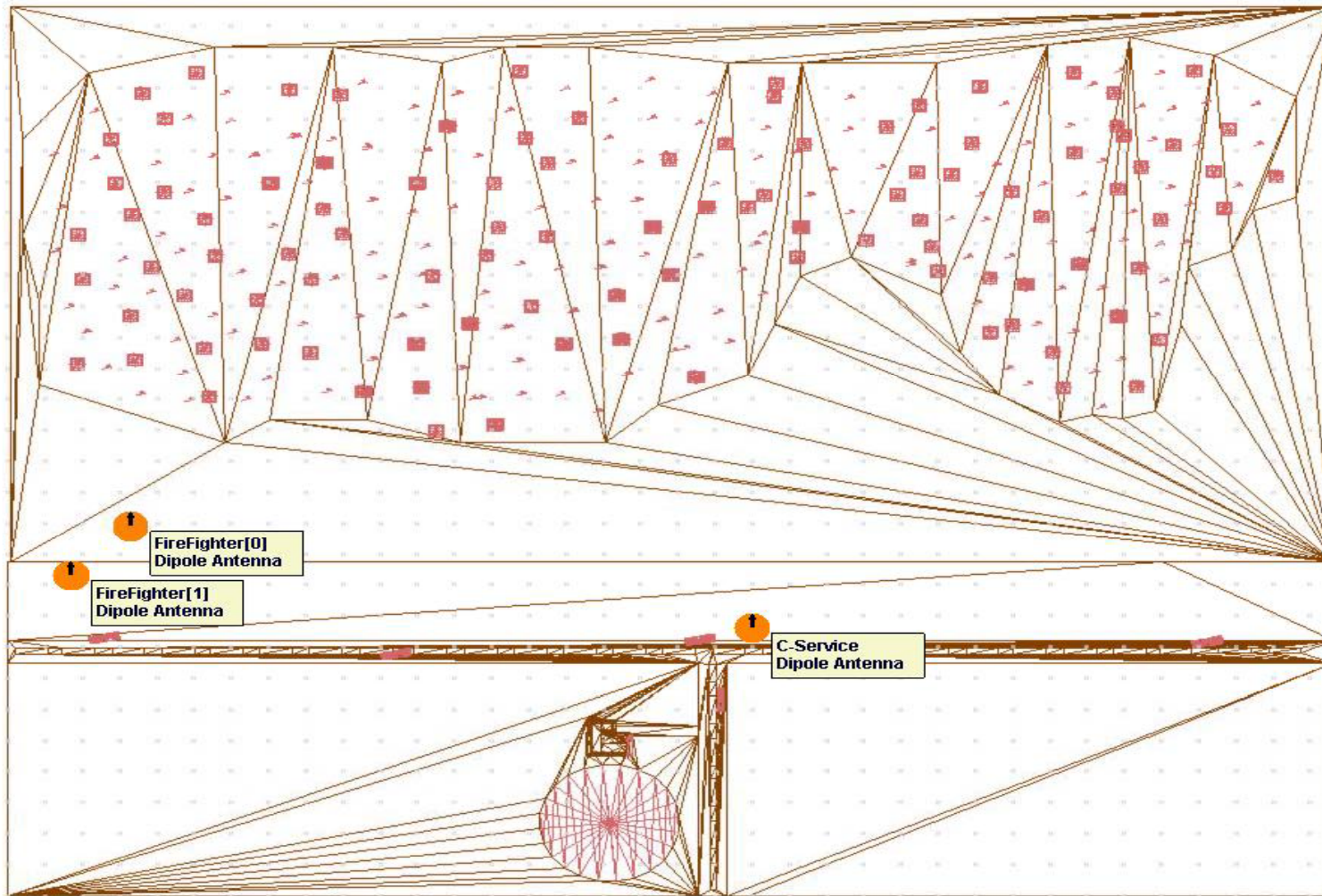


IEEE 802.11b $f = 2.4 \text{ GHz}$

 Fully overlapping channels
 Constant datastreams
 Wi-Fi: 100 mW
 ZigBee: 10 mW
 Dipole antennas

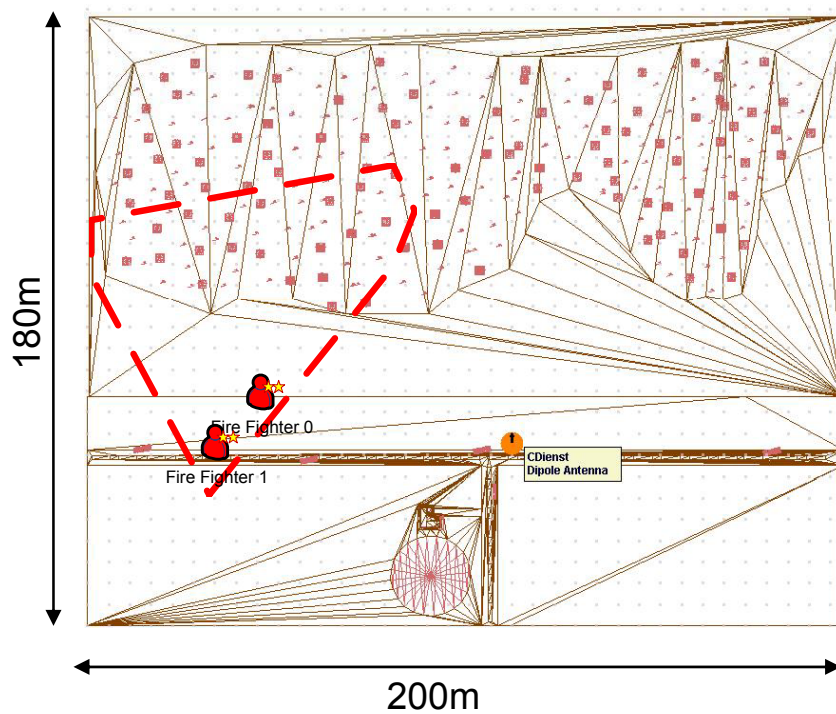
Multiscale Simulation Environment based on OMNeT++



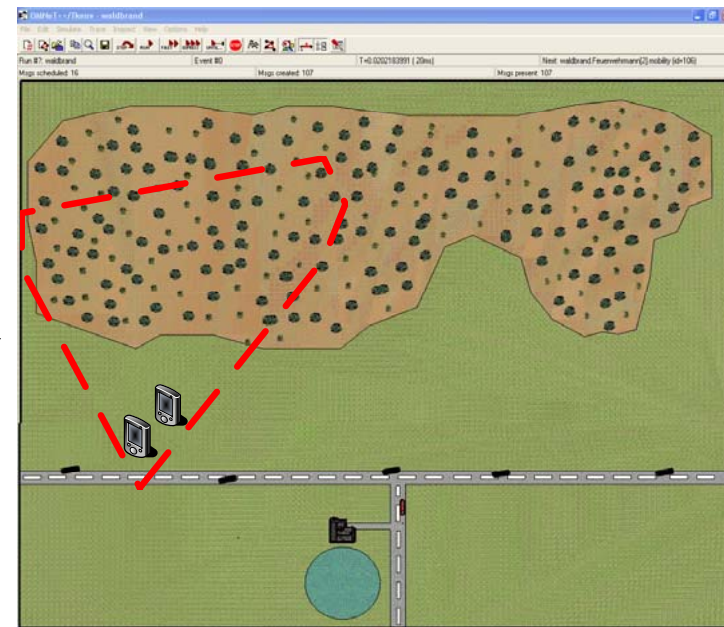
Application Scenario Forest Fire



OMNeT++ View on Application Scenario

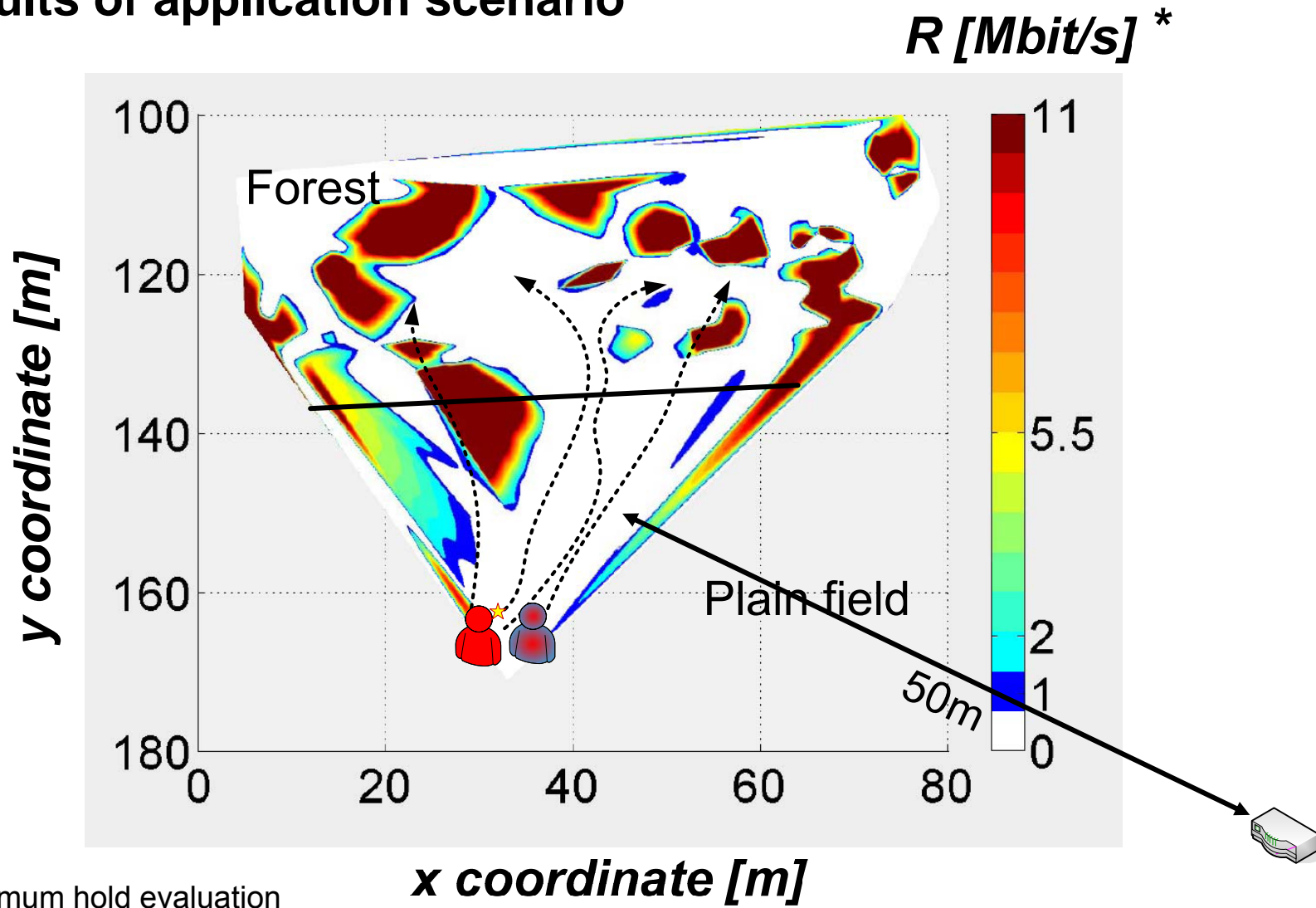


Raytracing Tool

Conclusions

- Online raytracing channel model
- Combination of static RSSI values with dynamical C/I changes
- Interference model adaptable to various application fields
- Much disturbance is expected during simultaneous use of Wi-Fi and ZigBee

- Adaption to different wireless technologies (e.g. WiMAX or LTE)
